



# COMMITMENT TO THE PREVENTION OF SEXUAL EXPLOITATION, ABUSE AND HARASSMENT (PSEAH)

## 1. Commitment

Mary Ward International Australia (MWIA) is committed to the prevention of sexual exploitation, abuse and harassment within the workplace and throughout its programs. This commitment extends to promoting and prioritising the safety and wellbeing of children and vulnerable adults who may come into contact with MWIA staff, volunteers or programs, both in Australia and overseas.

This commitment is evident in the MWIA Discrimination, Bullying and Harassment Policy, with specific commitments to the prevention of sexual exploitation, abuse and harassment of children detailed within the MWIA Child Safe Policy and Safeguarding Code of Conduct.

Each person involved in MWIA's work has a duty to know, understand and comply with these policies, to be able to recognise signs and risks of harm, and know how to respond appropriately.
